

Why most AI projects fail before the model does

Two companies buy the **same** AI. One automates thousands of hours of work; the other quietly switches it off six months later. The difference is almost never the technology — it's **five operational layers** underneath it. Skip one, and the agent acts straight through the gap. Here's the whole map — and how to tell, in about sixty seconds, which layer **you're** missing.

THE FIVE LAYERS ask each question about your own org →

I Governance Management for AI — who owns the risk, which use-cases ship, how much autonomy it gets.	“Who is responsible for AI here?” → If the honest answer is “everyone — so, really, no one.”
2 Clean Data One source of truth — or the agent reasons confidently over contradictions.	“Who is your biggest customer?” → If three systems give you three different answers.
3 Standardized Processes AI loves consistency; enterprises run on exceptions. Standardize <i>before</i> you automate. ★ IF YOU REMEMBER ONLY ONE — MAKE IT THIS	“How many ways are there to approve an invoice?” → If the real number is closer to 47 than to 1.
4 Controls Access, audit, rollback, monitoring — what stops a <i>fast</i> mistake becoming a <i>slow</i> disaster.	“Who reviewed what the AI decided last week?” → If the question lands in silence.
5 Operating Model Funding, ownership, roadmap, lifecycle. Pilots don't scale; capabilities do.	“Who owns the agent now that it's live?” → If it's “the project team... who've moved on.”

Every AI agent is really a **digital employee** — one that works at machine speed and never asks a clarifying question. Would HR onboard a human with **no manager, no training, no audit trail, no review?** The five layers aren't bureaucracy. They're just how you'd onboard one properly.

Take these five questions to **one** real use-case you're tempted to automate. Whichever question made you **wince** — that's your weakest layer, and that's where you start. Not the model. Rule of thumb: **don't automate a process you couldn't yet write down in one consistent way.**
